



## DARTS ALBERTA POLICY INDIVIDUAL TOURNAMENT GRANT FUNDING

POLICY NUMBER: 005

PAGE 1 OF 2

1. Applications will be considered from individuals or teams to attend an event where the applicant has qualified to progress to the next level of competition.
2. Applications to attend open events where any individual or team may gain or purchase entry will be considered ineligible for funding.
3. Applications to attend zone, regional or provincial championships will be considered ineligible for funding.
4. Applications to attend events where a Darts Alberta initiative is already in place may be deemed ineligible for funding.
5. Provided funding is available at the time of application, grants to attend National Championships associated with service clubs shall be granted at a flat rate of the maximum per event total divided equally amongst the applicants for that event – **to a maximum of \$250 per applicant** regardless of the location of the event (see example).
6. Notwithstanding Clause 7, provided funding is available at the time of application grants to attend other events as listed in Schedule 1 of this Policy shall be granted at a flat rate of the maximum per event total divided equally amongst the applicants for that event – **to a maximum of \$500 per applicant** regardless of the location of the event (see example).
7. In order to be eligible to apply, the applicant must:
  - Be a member of Darts Alberta, in good standing, prior to qualification of the event;
  - Make application to Darts Alberta **a minimum of 30 days prior to the start date of the championship;** and
  - Provided written verification of qualification upon request.
8. 100% of the funding will be disbursed upon the applicant's signing of the Grant Agreement.
9. Although a post-event report shall not be required, each applicant will be expected to advise the Darts Alberta Secretary of his or her tournament result from that event.

Maximum Grant Approval Examples:

**1 Grant Application received to attend the World Cup**

- Event Maximum = \$4,000; Per Applicant Maximum = \$500
- Maximum grant approval = \$500

**2 Grant Applications received to attend the Legion Nationals**

- Event Maximum = \$1,000; Per Applicant Maximum = \$250
- Maximum grant approval = \$250 per applicant

**10 Grant Applications received to attend the Elks Nationals**

- Event Maximum = \$1,000; Per Applicant Maximum = \$250
- Maximum grant approval = \$100 per applicant
