1 LEVEL I OFFICIATING WORKSHOPS

- 1.1 Darts Alberta shall offer workshops throughout the Province of Alberta for Level I Officiating for the Sport of Darts, facilitated by a Certified Course Conductor.
- 1.2 The purpose of the Level I Officiating Workshop shall be to train officiators (referees) for the Sport of Darts by providing current and new tournament organizers with a general overview of the following:
 - How to Organize a Tournament
 - How to Obtain Sponsorship
 - Provincial Ranked Tournaments
 - Darts Alberta Zones & Provincials
 - NDFC Ranked Tournaments
 - NDFC Rules
 - Overview of Stage Play Functions
 - Tournament Formats
 - Draw Sheets & Seeding Instructions
- 1.3 Each workshop participant shall receive a Level I Officiating Workshop binder complete with an NDFC Rulebook.
- 1.4 As the intent of the Level I Officiating Workshop is to be an introduction to officiating, there shall be no prerequisite required.
- 1.5 The cost of the workshop shall be as identified in the Policy for Fees and Rates Schedule.

2 LEVEL I OFFICIATING CERTIFICATION

- 2.1 In order to obtain full Certification as a Level I Officiator for the Sport of Darts, individuals must:
 - Attend the one-day Level I Officiating Workshop
 - Successfully complete the Level I Officiating Open-Book Examination
- 2.2 Upon achieving certification, each Level I Certified Officiator for the Sport of Darts shall receive:
 - Certificate of Achievement
 - Photo Identification Badge

3 MEMBER LEAGUE WORKSHOP SPONSORSHIP

- 3.1 To encourage Member Leagues to participate in this Certification Program, Darts Alberta shall provide a one-time number of reimbursable Workshop Registrations:
 - Youth League – 2 workshop registrations
 - Adult League of 25 to 99 Members – 5 workshop registrations
 - Adult League of 100 to 249 Members – 10 workshop registrations
 - Adult League of 250+ Members – 15 workshop registrations
- 3.2 The pre-registration course fee shall be paid, in advance of the workshop, for each Member League participant.
- 3.3 The pre-registration course fee shall be refunded upon completion of certification.
- 3.4 Any unused reimbursable registrations shall carry forward to the following year.
