Darts Alberta executive seeks feedback on provincials format

A great many issues were brought forward regarding the 2009 Adult Provincial Championship. The two primary factors related to changes involving:

- Not all players advancing to the knockout (depending on the number of registered participants).
- A restructured draw from a Beta Double Elimination Draw to a truly and completely seeded Double Elimination Draw.

It was announced at the 2009 Annual General Meeting that members would be given the opportunity to provide recommendations for changes to the provincial format. The purpose of this exercise is to provide members with the opportunity to recommend solutions, not simply to provide feedback on what they aren't happy with.

Depending upon the amount and type of feedback received, an Adhoc Committee may be formed including an assortment of members (elite, intermediate, male, female) to review the submitted proposals and to provide recommendations to the Executive.
