Vegas Qualifier changed to the "BY" and "SSS" Classics.

Due to the PDC revamping their qualifying process into their premier events there will no longer be a Vegas Qualifier offered to the NDFC. (This also applies to US players who were currently utilizing a ranking list of their own for qualifying purposes).

The new qualifying process to this event is through the PDC order of merit to the top North American and Canadian players, based on their order of merit attained at the Players Championships events which now consists of seven North American tournaments. (One Canadian tournament at this time).

The NDFC has developed a new qualifier for this change that will be called the "BY Classic" for the Men and the "SSS Classic" for the Ladies, this means we will still award the top two players in each category a prize package. The newly named events are in appreciation of our two most loyal sponsors. (BY Group and Specialty Sport Supplies).

These events will still utilize the qualifying criteria used for the old Vegas Qualifier with all results still being submitted to Kip Morrish, as well as the usual ranking package submissions to the ranking officer Maggie Leblanc. (This does not affect the ranking list awards that will stay unchanged).

The prizes available will be airfare and two night's accommodation to the closest out of province WDF tournament, separate accommodation to each recipient.

These changes take effect for the 2009 season.
